## **Cross-border agglomeration Basel**

## 3 countries in a few hours

There are only about 150 places worldwide where the borders of three states come together at one point, and 48 of those are located in Europe. But hardly any other European region operates across borders so closely and successfully as the Trinational Metropolitan Region Upper Rhine. With its 6 million inhabitants, it forms a unique shared cultural, living and economic environment and can serve as a modell for other Tri-state areas. The aim of the trip is to experience and understand the various cross-border links. The excursion goes by foot, tram, bus and with the Rhine ferry through the tri-national agglomeration of Basel.
