

Sustainable Mobility in Freiburg

3-hours program by tramway

In 1969, the City of Freiburg adopted its first General Traffic and Transport Plan. Since then it is one of the aims of its urban traffic and transport policy, guaranteeing mobility without adverse impact on nature and environment. This policy, which has drawn attention across the country but also abroad, promotes environmentally friendly modes of travel. More than 70% of trips in Freiburg are done by foot, by bicycle and local public transport. Freiburg received several awards for its environmentally friendly mobility conception.

- Introductory lecture about environmentally friendly mobility and urban development in Freiburg.
- Visit of Freiburg Central Station which is the central traffic hub of the city. The tramway bridge crossing the station allows for easy combination of rail and urban public transport. Car sharing and the bicycle station with space for 1000 bikes completes the concept.
- Tour through the historic city centre with focus on mobility and the actual extension of the pedestrian zone.
- Walk at the district behind the train station, where a transformation of public spaces and streets helped to improve the quality of life.
